

J3 Resources, Inc. Earns Exceptional Vendor Performance From Texas Department of Transportation

The Texas Department of Transportation writes, “In the remediation of Parcel 215, Houston, a berm needed to be built to prevent contaminated storm water from an adjacent property from running into Parcel 215. Prior to building the berm, soil samples needed to be analyzed to determine whether the area to be under the berm was ‘clean’. These analyses needed to be done on a very expedited schedule in order to be able to build the berm before predicted rains could occur. Fourteen soil samples were delivered to J3 after 17h30. Contract turn-around time for the analyses is 24 hours. After notice of the urgency the next business day, J3 analyzed the samples and delivered the results by 11h00 of that business day. J3’s exceptional response allowed time to construct the berm (400’ long by 8’ wide at the top with 2:1 side slopes) prior to the predicted rains starting”.
