J3 Offers Manganese Testing

Manganese, a mineral essential for living organisms has been determined to cause adverse neurological and neurobehavioral health effects in humans if exposures exceed new threshold limit values. In February 2013, the American Conference of Governmental Industrial Hygienists (ACGIH) reduced the Threshold Limit Value (TLV) for respirable manganese from a time-weighted average (TWA) limit of $0.2\text{mg}/\text{m}^3$ to $0.02\text{mg}/\text{m}^3$. This reduction of the TLV was in response to pre-clinical studies of neurobehavioral and neuropsychological deficits of workers exposed to manganese.
